...as a coffee table your Stealthpac 95 has a weight capacity of 30kg // 66Lbs.



...as a fridge/cooler stand your Stealthpac 95 has a weight capacity of 110kg // 242Lbs.



...you can keep tabletop and other frame parts separate in the dual pocket carry bag.



### BAMBOO SURFACE CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is required to keep the bamboo surfaces in good condition.

For daily cleaning, it is recommended to use only hot water and a soft towel or sponge. Avoid household cleaning products that may use degreasers or abrasives. Degreasers can attack the coating on the tabletop.

#### Re-Finish Bamboo Surfaces:

To keep the bamboo surfaces in great condition it can be reoiled using a linseed or tung oil. Both linseed oil and tung oil (in their purest forms) are non-toxic, eco-friendly and food-safe. They're both plant-based oil finishes that penetrate and saturate the wood grain.

- Using a soft brush and water, wipe down your table and allow to dry.
- Gently sand using 200-240 grit sandpaper, sanding in the same direction as the grain in the bamboo. Once sanding is complete, clean and remove any dust etc. from the bamboo.
- Apply the oil using a soft paint brush. Apply liberally to ensure even coverage and brush in the direction of the grain.
- Within 5 minutes of applying oil use a clean dry rag to wipe off the excess oil.
- Allow to dry for 1 hour.
- Re-coat as required.

### Removing Mould and Stains:

If mould has appeared on the bamboo surfaces, it is possible to remove mould and stains to restore the surface.

- Wet the bamboo surface, then scrub with a stiff brush using an anti-fungal wash.
- Once the bamboo is dry, sand the surface. Start with a medium-coarse sandpaper 60-80 grit, once any stains or mould marks are removed, gently sand using 200-240 grit sandpaper, sanding in the same direction as the grain in the bamboo. Once sanding is complete, clean and remove any dust etc from the bamboo.
- Once sanding and cleaning have been completed, it is important that the surface of the bamboo is sealed immediately with oil again. Apply according to instructions above.

### **Aluminium Frame Care and Maintenance:**

Aluminium is designed to withstand various weather conditions, requiring minimal upkeep. A gentle mix of mild soap and water with a soft brush (such as nylon bristles or soft-textured natural brushes) or a clean lint-free cloth is ideal for cleaning.

To maintain its pristine appearance, a wipe down with a microfiber cloth every 2-3 months should suffice to remove any slight dirt buildup or clouding. This routine is particularly crucial if you're near the beach to prevent unsightly salt accumulation on the frame.






















### 2 Year Limited Warranty

All our products come with a guarantee designed to protect you as our valued customer. Zempire® Camping Equipment will repair or replace this product, at their discretion, should it fail due to faulty materials or manufacture for a period of 2 years from the date of purchase.

The Guarantee is subject to the following conditions:
